- Prepare and review of annual property operating budgets and business plans to assist in achieving investment strategies.

- Monitor ESG objectives of assets and report to portfolio management.

- Take ownership of deal tracking system (DealPath).
- Prepare ad-hoc reports and participate in special projects.
