Main Purpose of the Role:

The Counsel & Compliance Officer role will support all aspects of in-house legal duties. Key responsibilities involve supporting the company's private equity and institutional investment platform, including the regulatory requirements of our SEC-regulated US investment adviser and globally regulated subsidiaries.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide legal advice with respect to formation, structuring and operations of U.S. and offshore private equity funds and separate accounts.
- Draft and negotiate private fund organizational documents and offering memorandums.
- Manage internal corporate governance deliverables such as legal entity tracking, maintenance of corporate books and records, and monitoring of regulatory compliance.
- Draft and negotiate additional investment documents including: joint venture operating
 agreements, limited partnership agreements, limited liability company agreements, subscription
 agreements, investment management agreements, separately managed account agreements and
 side letters (including negotiations with sovereign wealth funds, state pension plans, banks and
 governmental investment entities, and other institutional investors).
